Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for setting aside the impugned order dated 30.07.2022 (P-10), thereby services of petitioner as Hindi Mistress have been terminated.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the statutory appeal dated 18.08.2022 (P-11), pending with respondent No.1, is considered and decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the respondent No.1 (appellate authority) to consider and decide the aforesaid statutory appeal dated 18.08.2022 (P-11) of the petitioner on or before 31.10.2022 by passing reasoned order as per law if there is no legal impediment.

Needless to say that in case decision is taken adverse to the petitioner, she shall be well within her right of availing the remedy as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
