The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR bearing No.0200 dated 14.03.2020, under Sections 323, 34, 506 IPC (Sections 325, 379-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 17.12.2020, passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process and is not required for custodial interrogation. Even otherwise the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and in pursuance of the order dated 05.07.2021, passed in CRM-M-15951-2021, the parties have already got their statements recorded before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate with regard to the amicable settlement between the parties.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has already joined the

investigation but there is a recovery of some gold items.

Since the matter in the present case has already been compromised between the parties as per learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner has already joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 17.12.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.
