Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.118 dated 15.09.2021 registered under Sections 306, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 10.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 13.10.2021 passed by this Court in CRM-M-43242-2021,whereby concession of pre-arrest bail has been granted to the co-accused.

Notice of motion for 25.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-43242-2021 ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance

of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Manjeet Singh, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.11.2021 is made absolute.
