RAM BAHADUR AND ANR VS FAHIMUDDIN AND ORS

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rs. Eight Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants would submit that during the pendency of this appeal, appellant No.1-Ram Bahadur has since expired leaving behind only one claimant i.e. his wife, appellant No.2-Kalawati. Counsel has requested that the cheque amount be made out in the name of appellant No.2-Kalawati.

Ordered accordingly.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.8,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.2 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 45 days from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The

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appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
