[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the
respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated
25.08.2022, in CWP No.18840 of 2022 in case titled as 'Jaswant Singh
Lamba and anotherversusState of Haryana and another'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.18840
of 2022 was disposed of vide order dated 25.08.2022 by directing the
respondent to decide representation dated 14.08.2022 within ten days from
the date of receipt of copy of order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case.

[4] However, learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, has produced copy of
order dated 15.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained
in representation dated 14.08.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy
thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal
thereof, states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant
petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order
dated 15.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
