Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is entitled for promotion to the post of TGT Mathematics from the date person junior to him has been promoted, with all consequential benefits. Learned counsel submits that despite the fact that the petitioner was fully eligible for the said promotion keeping in view the qualifications envisaged, the petitioner has not been promoted and that too without specifying any valid reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has raised the said grievance by way of serving a legal notice dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) which is pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from receipt of copy of this order.
