The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

Learned State counsel submits that representation dated 06.06.2022 has been considered in terms of order passed by this Court on 16.09.2022 and decide the representation on the statement of mother of the petitioner who gave her no objection to the prayer made in the petition.

Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No. 5 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. She submits that respondent No. 5, being the mother of petitioner No. 2 is concerned about her well being, and since, her whereabouts are not known, would file a Habeas Corpus Petition.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the State submits that this case has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
