Pleadings on record would indicate that the GST registration of the petitioner had been cancelled vide order dated 29.07.2021 (Annexure P-3). An application thereafter had been moved for revocation of cancellation of registration under Section 30 of the CGST/HGST Act, 2017 read with Rule 23 of the CGST/HGST Rules, 2017 on 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Instant writ petition was filed with a short grievance that the application seeking revocation of the GST registration is not being considered inspite of sufficient time having elapsed.

Since an advance copy of the petition had already been served upon the respondents. Ms.Shruti Jain Goyal, learned DAG, Haryana has

made available copy of an order dated 14.09.2022 issued by the Excise and Taxation Officer, Gurgaon (East), Ward No.10 and as per which the cancellation of the GST registration of the petitioner stands revoked.

Copy of such order dated 14.09.2022 is taken on record as mark 'A'.

In view of such development, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
