The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to ensure that the revision petition filed by the petitioner dated 12.08.2021 is decided on merits in a bonafide, impartial and unbiased manner by giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner unlike the entire departmental proceedings carried out against him pursuant to the chargesheet dated 15.11.2020 whereby he was dismissed from the service; along with certain other prayers.

The counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the statutory revision has already been filed against the impugned order passed by the respondents. Hence, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, it is clarified that the present order shall not have any adverse effect upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner.
