Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though in the present petition, the show cause notice as well as order of suspension and the chargesheet has been challenged but the same are not being pressed at this stage and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, the respondents are directed to supply the petitioner all the documents which have been made part of the chargesheet.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that once the documents relied upon have been mentioned in the chargesheet itself, there is no reason as to why the same are not to be supplied to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, the documents which have been mentioned in the chargesheet so as to be relied upon in the enquiry proceedings, if not already given to the petitioner, the same will be supplied to the petitioner within a period of next two weeks.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he also intends to move a representation for shifting his headquarter as mentioned in the order of suspension.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any grievance is raised by the petitioner by way of an appropriate representation, the same will be dealt with in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed on the same within a period of 4 weeks from receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
