HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 has been transferred by the impugned order dated 11.09.2022 (Annexure P-6), which has led to the situation that there is no teacher to teach the subject which petitioner No.1 was teaching in the school and the Principal of the school has already made a recommendation to the authorities concerned that keeping in view the circumstances which has arisen after the transfer of petitioner No.1, the students will suffer.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that a representation has been filed by the members of the Gram Sabha to the District Education Office, Dadri dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-8) which representation is still pending consideration with the respondents and the

petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that representation of the petitioner dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-8) will be decided within a period of 10 days. Till then, petitioner No.1 will be allowed to continue at the present station and in case, she has already been relieved, she will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
