Learned counsel for the appellant states that this case relates to damage of property (*Dhaba*). The liability of Insurance Company is limited to the extent of Rs.7,50,000/- but the Learned MACT, Sonipat has awarded only Rs.6,00,000/-. Now, they are seeking enhancement of compensation much more to that and it has also been pointed out that in that background, notices were issued to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 (driver and owner) but despite service they did not appear and in this background, there does not seem any likelihood of the matter being settled by way of compromise and requests that the case be sent back to the Hon'ble High Court for adjudication on merits.

Ordered accordingly.
