After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court concerned within one week positively and would move an application there for seeking the relief of regular bail and he prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Mr. Shashank Bhandari, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, who has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1-UT (Chandigarh) in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to this respondent in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having

been withdrawn with a direction to the trial Court concerned that in case the petitioner surrenders before it within the afore-stipulated period and moves any application for seeking the above-mentioned relief, the same be decided, in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the case, within a period of two (02) days thereafter.
