Through this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondent No.4.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 30.10.2021 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga, submitted by the learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition was filed on 15.12.2020 but due to Covid-19 pandemic, same was not listed earlier; that the challan was presented on 18.06.2020 but the concerned police, in order to extend a helping hand to the accused, had intentionally not attached suicide note and complaint dated 23.01.2020 with the challan and that the petitioner approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M-15252-

2020, for proper and fair enquiry but same was withdrawn on 15.07.2020 because during the pendency of the same, the challan was presented.

Learned State counsel points out that as per the reply, during investigation no suicide note was found. However, he does not dispute that the challan stands presented and the charges have also been framed.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents on record.

Since the charges have already been framed and during investigation, no suicide note was found, no further order is called for in the petition.

The petition is disposed of.
