Main case:

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.53 dated 02.05.2021, registered at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC deleted on 10.09.2021).

Vide order dated 23.11.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 23.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Naresh Pal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.11.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
