ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Prayer in the present petition is for directing the official respondents for getting the report under Section 173 CrPC in FIR No.225 dated 27.06.2022 and after getting it, investigate from an competent and honest officer preferably from outside Ferozepur Sub Division and for taking the action against the private respondents.

Notice served upon the official respondents through the State counsel. No notices are required to issue to the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case, he is permitted to file a representation to the concerned SSP and the said representation be decided within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, petitioner is permitted to file a representation to the concerned SSP and in case, such representation is filed, the same be decided within 30 working days from the date of receipt of the representation, by passing a speaking and reasoned order. The said order be communicated to the representationist without any delay.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, liberty is reserved to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is partly allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
