The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 24.06.2019, registered under Sections 406/420 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 14.02.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute is about some money and as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner has to pay an amount of Rs.1,70,000/- to the complainant, which he is ready to pay and explore the possibility of some amicable settlement.

Notice of motion for 23.03.2020....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 14.02.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Prithvi Raj, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.02.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
