Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, in the petition, the challenge is also to the order of transfer of the petitioner to Kurukshetra vide order dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) but the same is not being pressed.

The grievance of the petitioner is that within a period one day, the petitioner has again been transferred from Kurukshetra to Yamuna Nagar on 13.09.2022, which action of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal as, no justification has come as to why the petitioner has been transferred again within a period of one day.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner has any grievance qua the transfer dated 13.09.2022, the petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate representation with the competent authority upto Monday i.e. 19.09.2022 and in case any such representation is filed, the same will be decided within a period of 10 days and till then in case, the petitioner has not been relieved from Kurukshetra, she will be allowed to continue there and in case, she has already been relieved, she will not be forced to join at Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
