At the outset, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has stated that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 09.12.2021, the petitioner has already joined investigation and he is fully cooperating with the investigation process. He has categorically on instructions submitted that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Although, the alleged recovery from the co-accused was of a commercial quantity but since the learned State counsel has not opposed the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the bar contained under Section 37 of the N.D.P.S. Act will not apply in the present case.

Consequently, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.12.2021 is hereby made absolute.
