Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.143 dated 15.09.2021, registered at Police Station DLF Phase 2, Gurugram, under Sections 420, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Vide order dated 15.11.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 15.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Chunni Lal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.
