This is an application for placing on record the petition under
Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Application is allowed. Petition under Section 13-B of Hindu
Marriage is taken on record as Annexure A.1.

CM No.3284-CII of 2022

As per petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act,
petitioner No.1 has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- by way of
demand draft as full and final settlement.

Today, both the parties are present in Court with their Adhaar
Cards. Since Cheque bearing No.194596 amounting to Rs.20 lakhs in
favour of Sharanjit Kaur – respondent drawn at Punjab National Bank, has
been given by the appellant in Court today itself, the period of six months
is waived off.

FAO-M-178-2013 (O&M)

The appellant has come up in appeal against the order and

decree dated 07.03.2013 whereby petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce has been dismissed.

The marriage was solemnised in May, 1998 between the parties. They are living separately since March, 2008 and there is no child from this wedlock.

Parties are present in Court today and they have made their respective statements which are taken on record. As per the statement of the respondent, she states that she has settled the matter mutually and will never claim maintenance from the appellant after getting decree of divorce. She is ready to give divorce to the appellant on her own free will and without any pressure or influence. The appellant has also made a statement to this effect.

Keeping in view the statements made by both the parties, who are physically present to attend the Court proceedings today and are being represented through their counsels, appeal is allowed and the order and decree dated 07.03.2013 is set aside and the marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved by way of mutual consent between the parties. Decree-sheet be drawn accordingly.
