This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for transfer of investigation of FIR No.36 dated 17.04.2022 under Section 302 of IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-1) from local police to some independent investigating agency by acting upon the representation dated 20.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) given by the petitioner.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar to consider and decide the representations dated 20.08.2022 (marked to DGP, Punjab) & 25.07.2022 (Annexures P-3 & P-4).

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.3-

Senior Superintendent of Police, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.

Office is directed to send the copy of representations (Annexure P-3 & P-4) annexed with the petition to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar for necessary compliance.
