1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.11.2019, in CWP-12176-2013.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 06.11.2019, reveals that CWP-12176-213, was allowed in terms of decision of a Coordinate Bench in CWP No.10506 of 2002, in case titled as Dr. K.L. Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others, and the respondents were directed to take steps to release the benefits as admissible to the petitioner in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, failing which, the same were to be released along with interest @ 7.5% per annum, with effect from the date of entitlement till date of payment.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case.

4. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment as per entitlement in terms of order Annexure P/1 dated

07.11.2019, has been released to the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
