Though matters were being taken up through physical hearing mode today, this matter has been taken up through video conferencing on specific request of the learned counsel and in terms of circular dated 14.09.2021.

Pursuant to the order dated 12.11.2021, status report by way of an affidavit of Jatinderpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala has been filed. The same is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

Learned State counsel has referred to the averments contained in Para No.6 of the aforesaid status report. The relevant extract of the same is as under:-

'From the perusal of the statements, police file of the case, video clip, the investigation officer found that Harmanpreet Singh had got registered the main case by self suffered injuries. The cross case registered by Harmanpreet Singh S/o Hardev Singh R/o Sailowal against Harman Lal, German Lal sons of Jaswant Lal, Janak Raj, Jaswant Lal, Hans Raj and

Jaswinder Lal sons of Beli Ram, Akashdeep Singh, Mantu Sons of Janak Raj, Mohinder Singh S/o Wassan Singh and Kuldeep Singh S/o Mohinder Singh residents of Shailowal under Section 452, 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC was found to be true. The investigation/enquiry officer recommended to cancel the main case and continued the cross case proceedings. Accused Jaswant Lal son of Beli Ram, Vikas son of Janak Raj and Sukhjinder Singh @ Manto son of Janak Raj, all residents of village Shaillowal, P.S. Ghuman, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur were declared innocent during investigation of the case FIR No.07/2021 under Section 302 and 307 IPC Police Station Ghuman,. The said report was duly approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala.'

Confronted with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take all pleas available to him as per law at appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
