Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are facing disciplinary proceedings, which proceedings are not brought to the logical end and the pendency of the said proceedings is causing prejudice to the petitioners on the ground that due to the pendency of such proceedings, the petitioners have been denied promotion to the higher rank. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners' prayer is for concluding the disciplinary proceedings in a time bound manner, so that the petitioner could avail appropriate remedy including promotion in case found eligible after the conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the said grievance of the petitioners has already be raised by way of a legal notice dated 18.08.2022 (Annexure P-11) served upon the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case, the respondents are directed to decide the said legal notice in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection with regard to deciding the legal notice dated 18.08.2022 (Annexure P-11) by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice 18.08.2022 (Annexure P-11) of the petitioners by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of two months from the receipt of copy of this order.
