Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.140 dated 07.06.2020 under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police
Station Kosli, District Rewari.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was
passed by this Court on 10.11.2021: -

*“...Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the
petitioner is named in the FIR along with four other co-accused,
but he was found innocent by the police, as he was not found to be*

present at the spot. He was summoned on an application preferred under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. He also contends that besides the statement of the complainant there is no prima facie material which would connect the petitioner with the alleged commission of offence. He is being arraigned as an accused, as he is the father of main accused. He further contends that the similarly situated co-accused Tilak, who was also found innocent by the police, has been granted ad interim anticipatory bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court by order dated 14.10.2021 passed in CRM-M No. 43519 of 2021, which is listed for hearing on 09.12.2021...”

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and he is released on interim bail and is facing the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 10.11.2021 passed by this Court, vide which interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
