The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.381 dated 28.9.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 34 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

On 10.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* relies on issuance of notice and the grant of ad interim anticipatory bail to co-accused Sachin and Sagar, who had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M No.44917 of 2021 – Sachin and another Vs. State of Haryana.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 08.02.2022.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.44917 of 2021.

Before the adjourned date, the State shall file a concise status report.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.381 dated 28.09.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, district Faridabad, he shall be released on *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined the investigation; has cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 10.11.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
