Vide order dated 11.11.2021, this Court had granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner has consistently joined investigation as and when he was called upon to do so.

3. On the contrary, learned State counsel on instructions states that although the petitioner has joined the investigation but he has not cooperated.

4. At this stage learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has undertaken in the bail petition itself to fully cooperate and is ready to cooperate.

5. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 11.11.2021 is hereby made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall within 10 days inform the SHO regarding his financial details, assets movable or immovable, bank account details, Demat account, value of sovereign and cash in hand and continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so. It is clarified that in case he does not cooperate then it shall be open to the State to file an application for cancellation of the bail on this ground alone.
