1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.04.2019, in CWP-10796-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 25.04.2019, reveals that CWP-10796-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 05.03.2019, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any monetary benefits, to release the same to him within three months thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that although notice of motion was issued in the instant case on 02.09.2019, for 15.04.2020, yet in terms of order Annexure P/1 dated 25.04.2019, the respondent has passed order dated 30.12.2019, deciding the legal notice

and releasing the benefits to the petitioner as per entitlement determined

therein and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
