Given above, the statement given by respondent No.2 before the learned Illaqa Magistrate, is recalled.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed and liberty reserved to file a fresh petition in case, a genuine compromise arrived between the parties without influencing respondent No.2 or putting her under any kind of fear.
