This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment of medical bills submitted by the petitioner for treatment of his mother, who is suffering from 4th stage cancer and getting treatment from “Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute and Research Centre, Delhi”.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 31.08.2022 (Annexure P-9) or any supplementary representation to be made by the petitioner and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 31.08.2022 (Annexure P-9) or any supplementary representation which shall be made by the petitioner and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of two months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
