Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's service which she had rendered with the Kanya Gurukul Senior Secondary School, Khanpur Kalan, which was a Government aided school, has not been taken into account as qualifying service while computing the pensionary benefits of the petitioner, which action of the respondent is contrary to the settled principle of law settled by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-8441-2015** titled as **Devender Pratap Singh and another vs. State of Haryana and another** decided on 05.01.2016.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already deposited the CPF amount, for the period, for which, it was not deducted alongwith the interest hence, the service rendered by the petitioner from 16.07.1991 to 30.11.1998 needs to be taken into account as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits of

the petitioner.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 11.07.2022 (Annexure P/5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 11.07.2022 (Annexure P/5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her representation, respondent is directed to decide the representation dated 11.07.2022 (Annexure P/5) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
