Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.385 dated 20.9.2021, under Sections 323, 452, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Rohtak.

The FIR was at the instance of Kapoor, as per the allegations, the complainant was having money transaction with M/s Jhakar Enterprises. On 20.9.2021, Sanjeet along with his three friends came to the office of the complainant, abused him and gave beatings. He showed a pistol and threatened to eliminate the complainant in case money is not returned. On disclosure statement of Rajesh, pistol was recovered from a vacant plot.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody since 20.9.2021. It was a money matter, no injury was inflicted and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Mr. Gurminder Singh, Advocate appears for the complainant though not impleaded as party. He verifies the factum of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that the investigation is complete and challan stands presented.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the incident has a back drop of money transaction. No injury was inflicted. Investigation is complete. No recovery is to be made. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars. Bail is granted to the petitioners-Manesh and Sanjeet, on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
