M/S HEAVEN LOUNGE PVT LTD. AND OTHERS

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File has been put up in supplementary list today on the request of the respondent as this case was fixed for 13.10.2022 before Lok Adalat bench No.4 between the same parties as in CRR-1413 OF 2021.

On the complaint filed by the respondent, who is present in person under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the petitioners were held guilty of the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and sentenced to undergo imprisonment and pay the amount of compensation. Against the judgment of conviction and the order of sentence, appeal was filed before the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram and the same was dismissed. The petitioners, therefore, filed the instant revision petition.

The matter was directed to be placed before the Lok Adalat and notice was directed to be issued to both the parties. The respondent appeared in person and he has filed the print out of the notice which was received by him in CRR-1413 of 2021. While admitting the instant revision, the High Court vide order dated 30.11.2021 observed that the matters stood compromised between the parties and petitioners were thereupon be released on bail. The respondent has put in appearance today and made a detailed statement that he has received full and final payment of the amount

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to his satisfaction. He has therefore made a prayer that the permission may be granted to compound the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and further that revision may be allowed by setting aside the judgments of conviction and order of sentence passed by the Courts below.

In view of the above categorical statement made by the complainant in the Lok Adalat, the matter is permitted to be compounded and revision stands allowed by setting aside the judgments of conviction and order of sentence passed by the Courts below. The petitioners stand acquitted of the offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.
