Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.81 dated 06.07.2022, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, under Section 379-B IPC and Sections 120-B and 411 IPC (added later on).

Vide order dated 19.09.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 19.09.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajaypal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.09.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
