The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.74, dated 04.10.2021, under Sections 380, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar.

On 10.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia relies on issuance of notice and the grant of ad interim anticipatory bail in the case of similarly placed co-accused – Baljit Kaur, who had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M No.46464 of 2021 – Baljit Kaur Vs. State of Punjab.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gunkirat Kaur, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 14.02.2022.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.46464 of 2021.

Before the adjourned date, the State shall file a concise status report.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioners' joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of their arrest in FIR No.74 dated 04.10.2021 registered under Sections 380 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Jhander, district Amritsar, they shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioners have joined the investigation; have cooperated with the investigating agency and that their custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 10.11.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
