By this petition filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 6 dated 18.01.2020, registered at Women Police Station Rohtak, District Rohtak, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 201,506,34,376(2) (N) IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

Pursuant to the order dated 14.07.2022, the report of the learned trial Court dated 30.07.2022 has been received, stating to the effect that as a matter of fact the list of witnesses has been exhausted but the learned Public Prosecutor had requested for a short date to close the evidence after going through the case file properly.

That being so, I see no ground to admit the petitioner to regular bail at this stage.
