The short grievance raised in this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is that the appellate authority is not deciding the statutory appeal dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-1). The said appeal has been preferred aggrieved by the order dated 19.10.2021 cancelling the license of the petitioner to run a Fair Price Shop (Depot Holder) at village Khadak Mangoli, Old Panchkula, Tehsil and District Panchkula under license No.169 and POS Machine No.106900100030. She had been running the Fair Price Shop for the last sixteen years before the license was arbitrarily cancelled.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nidhi Garg, AAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service. She would submit that the appellate authority could be directed to decide the statutory appeal within some stipulated time.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting on the merits of the case or expressing any opinion, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to

decide the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
