Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the
petitioner in a case FIR No.359 dated 5.10.2021 under Sections 376, 506 IPC
registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.

By virtue of the order dated 30.11.2021, while granting interim
protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and already deposited the mobile phone with the Investigating Agency and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his mobile phone has also been recovered. He further submits that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and has prayed for dismissal of the present petition.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court finds that the matter needs a thorough investigation and to be decided on merits.

In view of the above, the order dated 30.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
