This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Affidavit of Inderbir Singh, IPS, Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur has been filed in compliance of order dated 11.11.2021. The same is taken on record.

A perusal of the said affidavit would show that the Police has already initiated action. The relevant extract of the affidavit is reproduced as under:-

8. That upon enquiry into the matter, following action has been taken against Respondents No. 4 and 5:-

(i) Directions were issued by the deponent to the concerned Station House Officer (SHO) to take suitable action against Respondents No. 4 and 5 i.e. Gurdeep Singh and Lakhveer Singh.

It has been informed by the SHO that preventive action has been taken under section 107/151 of the Code of Criminal

Procedure, 1973 against respondents No. 04 & 05 and on 20.1.2022, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Zira has ordered Gurdeep Singh and Lakhveer Singh to execute a bond for keeping peace, which has been accepted by the competent authority. Both Gurdeep Singh and Lakhveer Singh have been directed not to indulge in any dispute and any default may lead to strict action against them.

(ii) The .12 bore DBBL Gun of Gurdeep Singh is already deposited with Banta Singh & Sons., Arms & Ammunition Dealers, Zira since 29.1.2019.

Further, the .32 bore Revolver possessed by Lakhveer Singh has also been got deposited on 19.1.2022 with Banta Singh & Sons. , Arms & Ammunition Dealers, Zira.

In view of the averments contained in the reply so filed by the authorities and the action initiated by them, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
