Learned Senior counsel for the appellant has not pressed the appeal on merits but has only pointed out that as per the High Court Rules and Orders and the prevalent roster as of now, the matter should have gone to a Division Bench, where the tender matters are being listed. Learned Single Judge probably should not have heard the matter.

In the light of the above, the learned Single Judge would look into the matter on the date fixed or on an application to be moved by the parties bringing this position to the notice of the Court along with an application for vacation of stay for further steps to be taken, in accordance with law.
