During the course of hearing submissions of the two sides, it has been brought to the notice of this Court by learned counsel for the petitioner that the wife and her minor kids are facing great hardship as the respondent is not paying the maintenance dues since a long period of time and has made statement withdrawing the present transfer application with a request that maintenance may directed to be paid.

Be so as it may, the present transfer application is

allowed to be withdrawn, however, directions are issued to the Executing Court dealing with the matrimonial petitions under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act to ensure that complete arrears of maintenance are paid to the wife and the kids by the next date of hearing.
