On 11.11.2021, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0529 dated 19.10.2021, registered for offences under Sections 294, 323, 506 and 509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner urges that the allegation against the petitioner is that he was accompanying Puneet, husband of the complainant and they assaulted the complainant in the Court complex on 18.10.2021. Counsel urges that FIR is the outcome of a marital dispute between the complainant and her husband and the petitioner has been deliberately entangled as he is related to husband of the complainant. Counsel submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Upon instructions from ESI Rameshwar Dayal, she submits that as per the medical report, the complainant has two abrasions on a finger of left hand.

List on 21.04.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would appear as and when called for by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions from ESI Rameshwar Dyal, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
