VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

Learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners points out that the instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking to invoke the writ jurisdiction of this Court for protection of life and liberty on account of the impending investigation in FIR No.0344 dated 30.08.2022, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sector 9-A, Gurugram, Haryana. A further prayer has been sought against the investigating agency to not take any coercive steps against the petitioners.

After hearing the learned Senior Counsel, this Court is of the opinion that the prayer in the form of seeking protection and to restrain the investigating agency from taking any coercive measures, is a remedy which is available to the petitioners by means of filing an appropriate petition under the provisions of Criminal Procedure Code.

In view of above, the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedies available to the petitioners under the Criminal Procedure Code.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Pending misc. application, if any, shall also stand disposed off accordingly.
