This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of his suspension order dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.4.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that the representation dated 21.07.2022 (Annexure P-3), served upon the respondent No.3 by the petitioner should be decided expeditiously. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents and submits that respondent No.3 will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 21.07.2022 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the official responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
