Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner had discharged the duties of the higher post i.e. District Food and Supply Officer from 29.04.2008 to 01.07.2009 and as District Food and Supply Controller from 03.07.2012 to 28.08.2014, the benefit of which has not been given to the petitioner as the petitioner is entitled for the grant of salary of the post on which he has discharged the duties keeping in view the settled principle of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 12.05.2022 (Annexure P-10), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent

No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 12.05.2022 (Annexure P-10), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 12.05.2022 (Annexure P-10) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
