Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case having FIR No.0240 dated 29.11.2021 registered under Sections 379-B & 34 IPC, at Police Commissionrate Ludhiana, Punjab, on the basis of compromise dated 29.08.2022.

The counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* contended that the petitioner was falsely implicated in the present case and is languishing behind the bars for the last more than 1 years. Now, the matter has been compromised with the complainant and the copy of the compromise deed is Annexure P-2.

So, the prayer is made that the petitioner be granted regular bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and has resisted the present petition. However, on instructions from ASI Sadhu Singh, he has not refuted the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last

more than 1 year and that now trial is going on and out of total prosecution

witnesses, two prosecution witnesses have been examined till date.

Mr. Himanshu Chhabra, Advocate for respondent No.2 has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has admitted the factum of compromise and has not disputed the compromise deed (annexure P-2) and is having no objection, if the present petition is allowed.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
