SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

This is the seventh petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.111, dated 14.03.2020 registered for offence under Sections 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short "the NDPS Act), at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, Annexure P-1.

Heard counsel for the parties.

Besides 20 grams of heroin, 800 capsules of *Tramadol* weighing 527 grams, which falls within the ambit of commercial quantity, have been recovered from the petitioner. Rigour of Section 37 of NDPS Act is attracted. Not only this, as per the custody certificate filed by the State, petitioner is involved in three other cases, all of which have been registered against him for offence under the NDPS Act and he has been convicted in one of them. Keeping in view the above factors, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the petition, which is hereby dismissed.

It is clarified that any observation made hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
