[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.03.2022, in CRM-M No.11471 of 2022 in case titled as '**Jaspreet Kaur versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CRM-M No.11471 of 2022 was disposed of vide order dated 17.03.2022 by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 11.08.2021 filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 11.08.2021 has been rejected vide order dated 17.03.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 17.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] The same is not opposed to by the learned Asstt. AG, Punjab.

[5] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
