The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in cross-case registered vide Report No. 25, dated 06.06.2020, lodged under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506, 354-B, 379-B, 427, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, in case FIR No. 190, dated 05.06.2020, under Sections 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version, wherein, both the parties sustained injuries. While drawing the attention of this Court, learned counsel has submitted that only attribution to the petitioner is of inflicting a danda blow on the little finger of the complainant.

Learned counsel further submits that pursuant to order dated 15th November, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the

complainant, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. He, on further instructions submits that since the petitioner has joined investigation, her further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation is not required.

Heard.

In the facts and circumstances, as enumerated hereinabove, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 15th November, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
